

Mitigation Fees

- Mitigation is triggered during the Design Review. It will apply to new construction and remodel/additions. This will include living, garage, and storage.
- With every new building there is additional risk of fire and more medical aid calls.
- As of January 1, 2020, Accessory Dwelling Units less than 750 sq. ft. will not be assessed mitigation fees.
- Mitigation Fee Schedules for 2022 – NTFPD approved by the Placer County Board of Supervisors on October 26, 2021. Alpine Springs County approved by the Placer County Board of Supervisors on November 9, 2021.

- These fees are only used for purchase of fire equipment and facilities; it is not used for personnel.
- With Proposition 218, special tax or assessments are no longer a revenue source to keep up with development growth, new service, and infrastructure demands.

The ultimate purpose of the mitigation fees is to provide a continued level of service even as growth of new development increases. These fees, we hope, will be enough to continue our level of medical aid, fire safety, etc.

More buildings = increased risk
